Summer vacation care recap...

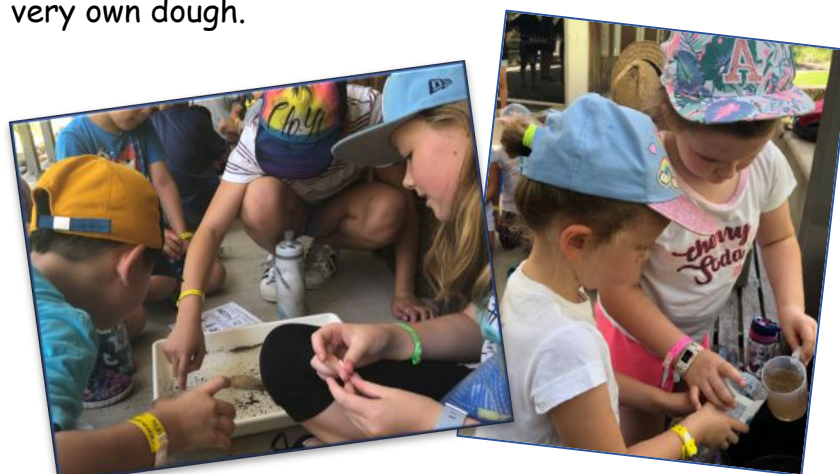


This Summer we had five weeks of
