If your child suffers from asthma or any allergies, we urge you to please ensure that your child's action plans and medication are up to date. Please also ensure that the centre has a copy of any action plans if we do not already have one! This is vital to your child/ren's health and safety, as in the case of something happening, we need all the information in order to help them and keep them safe.

## LATE PICK UP!

A reminder that if you are late to pick up your child from the centre, a late fee applies. This late fee is as follows; \$50 for the first five minutes and \$2 for every minute after 6:05pm. The centre closes at 6pm every evening, even during Vacation Care, Monday-Friday.

## REMINDERS

- If your child suffers from asthma or anaphylaxis under our policy we are required to have an updated **ASTHMA** action plan every 6 months and an **ANAPHYLAXIS** action plan updated every 12 months. We ask that if you have not given our centre an updated action plan to do so promptly
- There is now a 'Parent Communication Book' (it's **Black**), found on the sign in/out desk. In here, feel free to write any upcoming sessions your child may be absent from or any messages you need to communicate to staff, open to any ideas also!
- If your child is attending any **extracurricular** activities this term, please complete an 'Extracurricular form' located underneath the welcome notice board. Feel free to ask an educator if you need any assistance.

## PLEASE NOTE THAT YOUR CARE WILL BE SUSPENDED if

we do not receive an asthma/allergy plan from you in the next week. These plans ensure your child is SAFE. It is of the utmost importance that we receive these plans for the centre, or your care will be suspended at Ermington OOSH.

## IMPORTANT NOTICES:

It is extremely important to note that each family has a TOTAL of 42 absences within their CCS for each financial year. If you go over this amount, your CCS is stopped, and you will have to pay full fees for all attendance at OOSH.

Note that the financial year ends and re-sets on July 1<sup>st</sup> 2019.

## YUGIO/POKEMON CARDS

We would like to make it aware to all families, that Yugio, Pokémon and any other trading card system is banned at Ermington OOSH. This is a result of multiple fights between children due to the trading and stealing of cards. If your child chooses to bring these cards into the OOSH centre, please note that these are not the responsibility of the OOSH educators, and the children will be asked to put them into their bags. We will not be held accountable for these cards going missing. We suggest your children leave them at home to avoid any issues.
